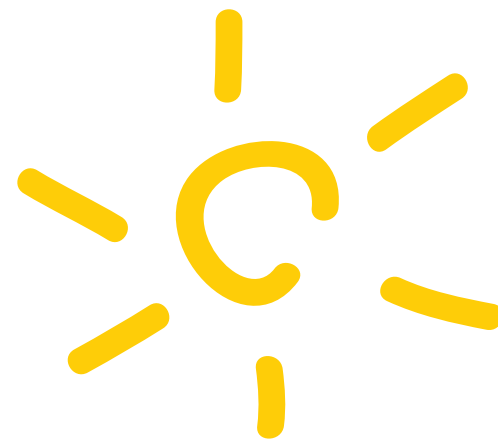

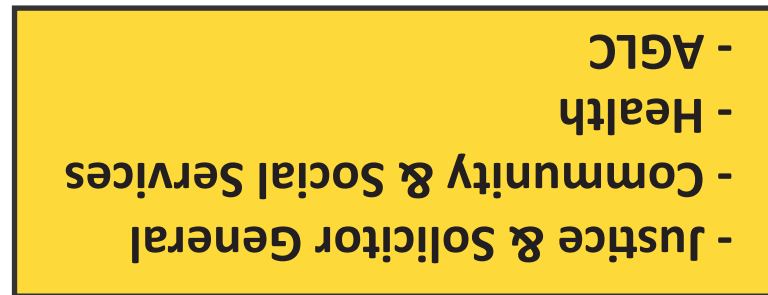

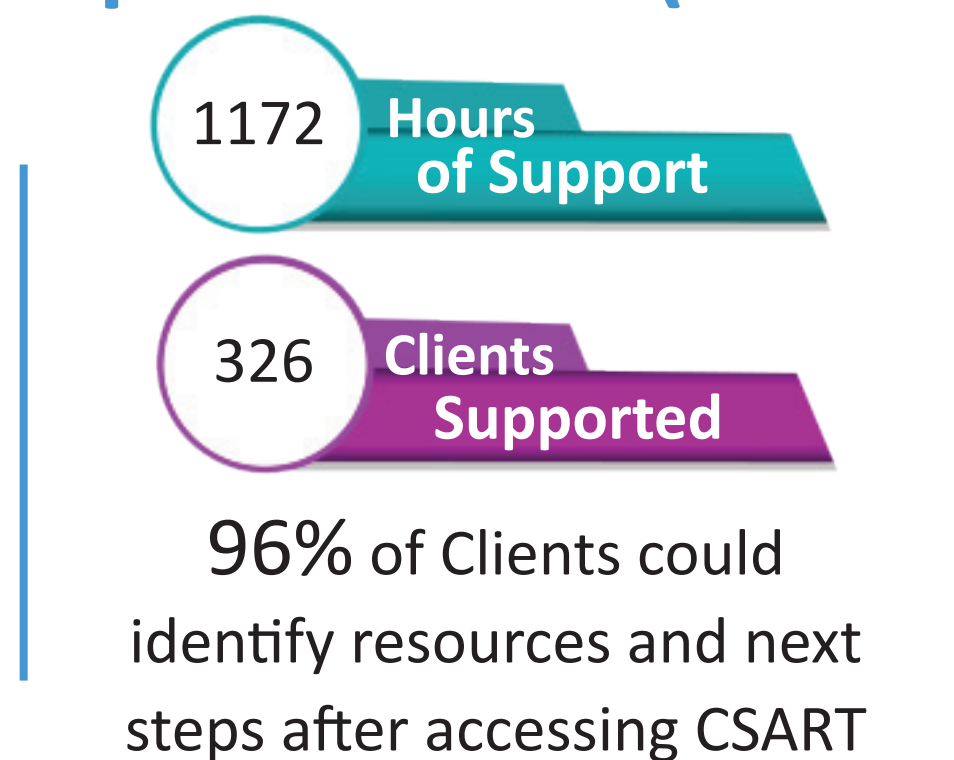
Services Overview 2018
