For over 25 years, CCASA has built a strong foundation and network of services to support communities in addressing sexual violence and the resulting myriad of complex issues for individuals, families, and communities.

CCASA is grounded in anti-oppressive practices and is committed to being equitable and inclusive while creating a safe space for all. We aim to be a representation of the communities we serve thus we welcome people of all diverse backgrounds to apply for this position. We are wanting to create space for the voices and experiences of Indigenous, racialized, LGBTQ2+ and those impacted by disabilities community members to help shape and build CCASA into a hub of support for those who are underrepresented and underserved. We also welcome voices from both female and male identified individuals who would like to work toward ending sexual violence. CCASA is also seeking individuals committed to and involved in their communities (however one defines what that community is).

In alignment with our core values, CCASA is looking for individuals that are collaborative, community centred, empathetic, innovative, and forward thinking. Currently we are welcoming the addition of a number of new board members who are committed to learning about and dealing with sexual violence in our community. CCASA Board of Director roles are volunteer positions and require committee work and monthly meetings. The average monthly commitment is between two to four hours.
